Sierra Leone is introducing an automated results verification system to replace the manual scratch card system.

The Ministry of Technical and Higher Education (MTHE) is at an advanced stage in the negotiations with the West African Examination Council (WAEC), and it is expected that the new result verification and pin vending system will be used in the next academic year.
