## REGULATORY CONDITIONS

1. **Undergraduate Programmes:** **MUST** not be above **23 years of age** and should have 5 credit in relevant subjects in the 2018/2019 WASSCE
2. Master's programme: Applicants **MUST** not be above 35 years old and possess a Bachelor degree with at least Second class, Second Division (Honours) and Second Division or better (General)
3. Ph.D. Programme: Must not be above 45 years old and holds a Master's degree

Completed application forms with all supporting documents should be submitted to the same website not later than **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2019.**
